

# Student Installation of Respondus Lockdown Browser (LDB)

Please follow the steps below to install the LDB program using Google Chrome. Click on the following link <http://www.respondus.com/lockdown/downloadc.php?id=655212977> to install the LockDown Browser.

**Step 1.** View the video that provides a brief explanation of Lockdown Browser. After viewing the video, click on the “Install Now” button.

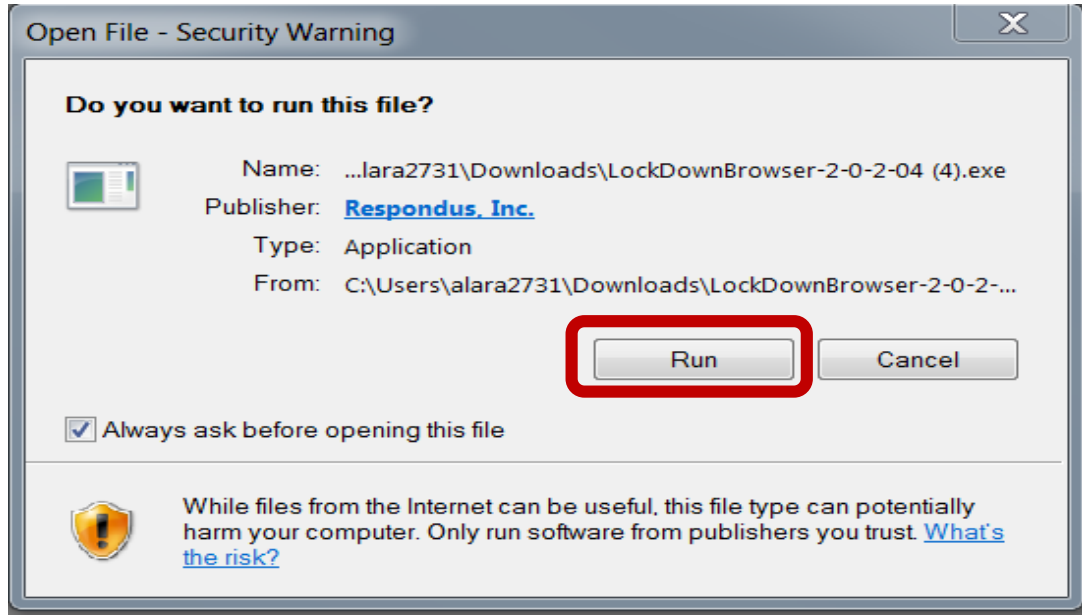

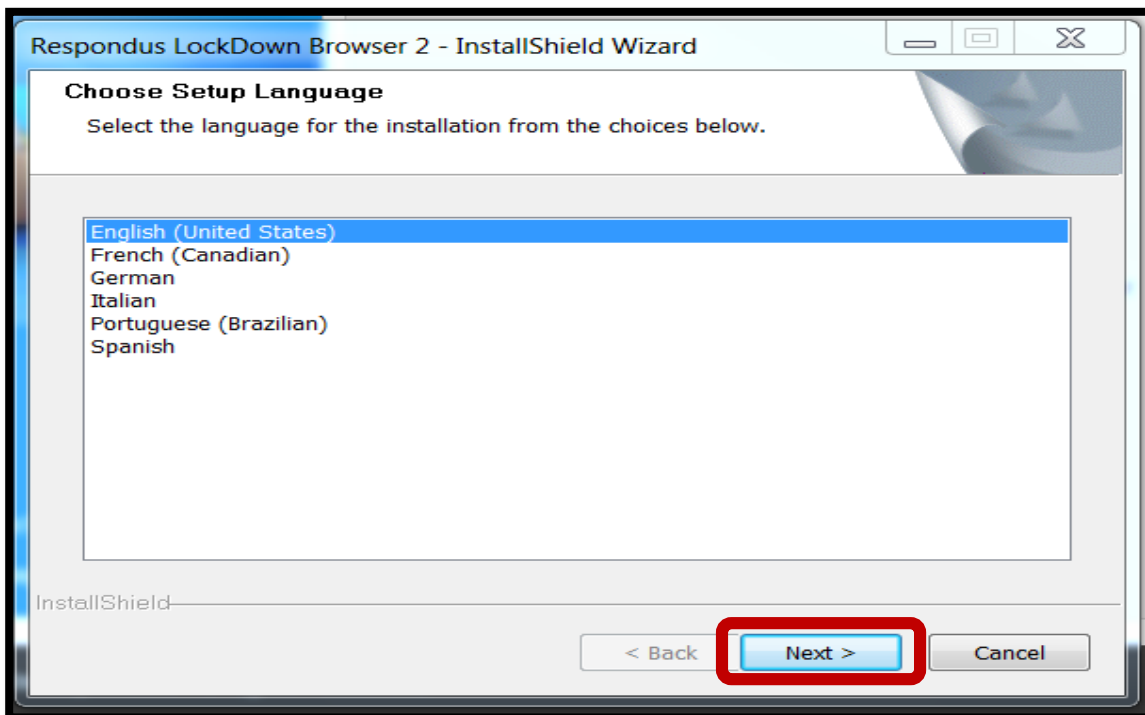

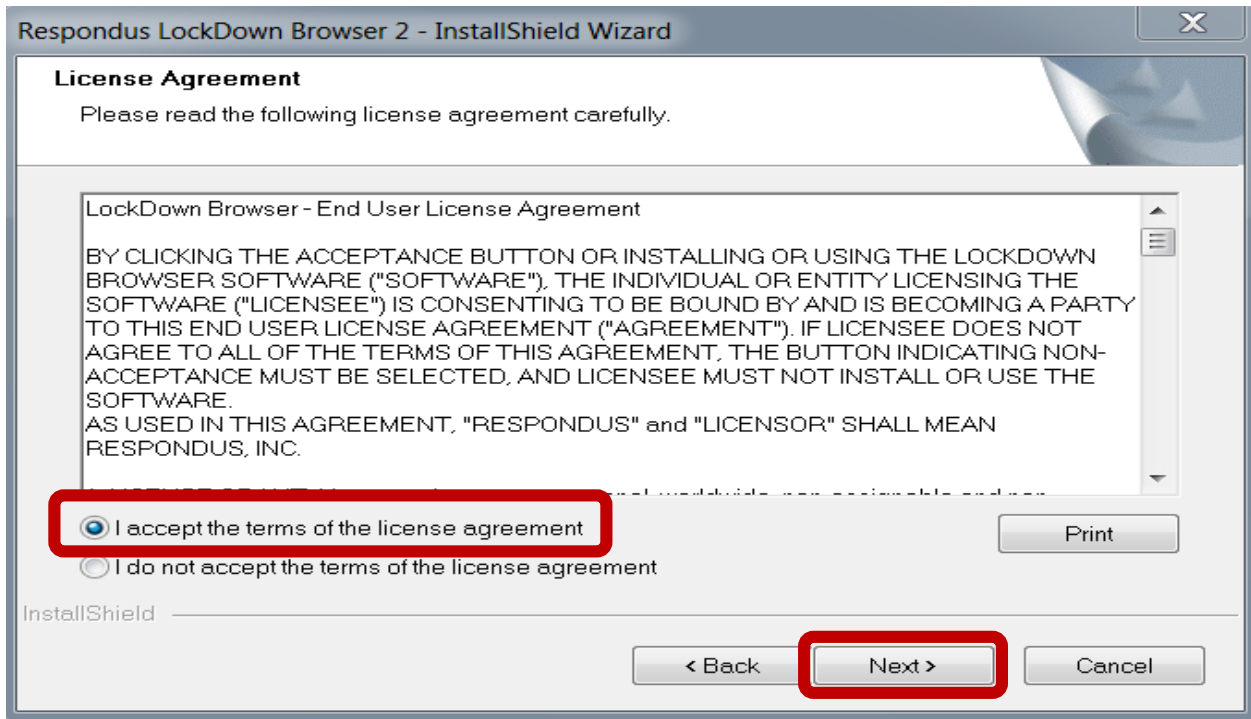
**Step 3.** A dialog box will appear. Click **“Run”**.



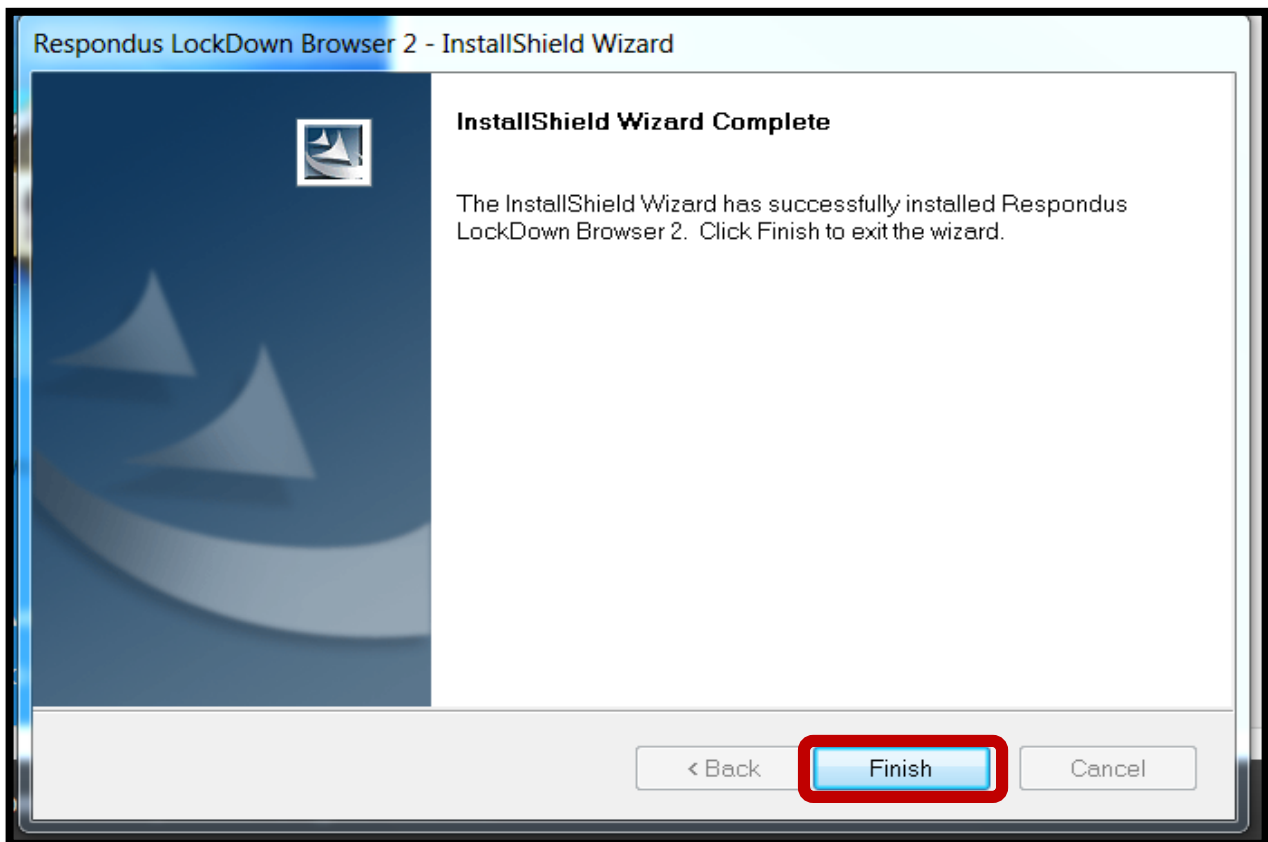
**Step 4.** Select **“English”** from the language list and click **“Next”**.



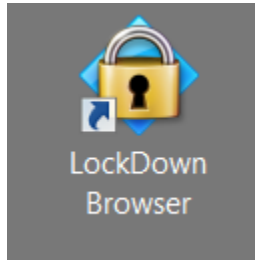
**Step 5.** Accept the license agreement and click **“Next”**.
