

Associate of Science General Studies

The Associate of Arts (AS) degree consists of two components: 42 SCH of Core Curriculum Courses and 18 credit hours of general electives. This degree is best suited for students who plan to transfer to a university to complete a Bachelor of Science degree. It is also appropriate for students who have not yet declared a major but are interested in academic or STEM disciplines. Only academic courses are applicable to the general elective requirement for this degree. General electives are selected based on selected major and the college or university the student plans to transfer to.
