DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION Mr. Robert Porter, Construction Project Manager, provided background information on the Commander's Residence (P-9), mentioned several THE PRESERVATION, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE INTERIOR OF THE HISTORIC FORT MCINTOSH COMMANDER'S RESIDENCE, INCLUDING BASIC FURNISHING OF THE INTERIOR PUBLIC AREAS - MS.
