



# EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

For emergencies, contact Laredo College Police at (956) 721-5303 or 911



## MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- Call Campus Police or 911 immediately
- If trained, administer first aid, CPR/AED
- Do not attempt to move the individual
- Provide comfort & support
- Avoid contact with blood or bodily fluids



## INCLEMENT WEATHER

- Seek shelter, remain inside the building
- Stay clear of windows
- Maintain communication with Campus Police and listen to weather updates



## FIRE

- Pull nearest fire alarm and call 911 immediately
- Move to nearest exit & evacuate
- Alert others to evacuate
- If area is filled with smoke, drop to hands & knees
- If clothes are on fire, DROP & ROLL



## SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE

- Do NOT touch or move the package
- Move away from the package and clear the area of all people
- Call Campus Police immediately from a campus phone



## ACTIVE SHOOTER

- Avoid. Move away from the source as quickly as possible
- Deny. Create barriers to prevent or slow down the threat from getting to you
- Defend. Be aggressive and committed to your actions
- Call Campus Police as soon as you are safe



## SUSPICIOUS/VIOLENT BEHAVIOR

- Call Campus Police immediately
- Leave the area or lock the door to separate self from suspicious/violent person
- Warn others to avoid dangerous person
- Remain in a secure space until arrival of police



## SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

- Call Campus Police
- Intervene or distract the perpetrator if safe to do so
- Contact the Title IX Coordinator at (956)794-4988



## GAS/HAZARDOUS MATERIALS LEAK

- Gas: Do NOT use cell phones or radios in immediate area
- Evacuate the area
- Call Campus Police immediately
