Quick Glossary of Terms

Credential of Value (COV) premium - the maximum time periods for a graduate to have a positive projected return on investment (ROI).

Occupational Skills Award - A credit program of 9 to 14 SCH or a workforce continuing education program of 144 to 359 contact hours

Institutional Credentials Leading to Licensure or Certification (ICLC) - A credential awarded by an institution upon a student's completion of a course or series of courses that represent the achievement of identifiable skill proficiency and leading to licensure or certification.

High-Demand Fields - A field in which an institution awards a credential that provides a graduate with specific skills and knowledge required for the graduate to be successful in a high-demand occupation. Pertains to credentials that receive additional funding based on the exceptional value of their academic fields, in the state or regional workforce.




Number of Students Earning Associate Degrees
