

Student Employment/Work Study Guidelines

FY 2025

In an effort to provide on-campus employment opportunities to Laredo College students the information below outlines the FY25 Student Employment/Work Study guidelines.

Terms and Definitions:

Work-Study Employment: Is a federally or state funded position that requires financial aid unmet need. Student must have a completed financial aid folder and must abide by all Federal and State financial aid regulations.

Work-Study Employment Criteria:

- Student must be an eligible citizen for employment.
- Student must submit a FAFSA application for the current academic year.
- Student must meet all eligibility requirements under Title IV.
- Student must have a minimum of \$2,750 unmet financial need per long semester (Fall/Spring).
- Student must have no pending documents with Admissions and/or Financial Aid.
- Student must be enrolled full-time (12 SCHs) at Laredo College.
- Student must maintain an institutional Laredo College 2.0 GPA throughout employment.
- Student must remain in good academic/financial aid standing at all times.

For summer terms: Students must have an unmet financial need of \$1,900 (Summer I and Summer II).

Student Employment: (formerly known as Institutional Work-Study) Is an institutionally funded position that does not require financial aid unmet need. Student must have a completed financial aid folder and must abide by all Institutional employment regulations.

Student Employment Criteria:

- Student must be an eligible citizen for employment.
- Student must have no pending documents with Admissions and/or Financial Aid.
- Student must be enrolled full-time (12 SCHs) at Laredo College.
- Student must maintain an institutional Laredo College 2.0 GPA throughout employment.
- Student must remain in good academic/financial aid standing at all times.

For summer terms: Students must be enrolled at least 6 SCHs at Laredo College.

Process to request a Student Employment/Work Study Position:

Step 1: Complete the 'Student Employment Position Request Form'

A 'Student Employment Position Request Form' must be completed for each department requesting a student employment or work-study position for FY25. Each request must be as descriptive as possible and will undergo the same evaluation process when determining the position allocations.

All completed forms must be submitted via email to workstudies@laredo.edu

Step 2: Department Supervisors must attend Supervisor Training

Student Employment/Work Study Supervisor Training will be required of all department supervisors that receive a student employment/work study position allocation before advertising vacancies. Information regarding the posting and advertising of positions will be shared with all supervisors during the training.

Notes:

Please note *no* positions will carryover from FY24.

Positions will be allocated based on a ranking criterion and the availability of funding.

Positions must be filled within 45 days of initial allocation. Failure to fill positions will forfeit allocation to the next deserving department.

Student Employment/Work Study position advertising begins	August 13 th
First possible date of employment for Student Employees/Work Studies for the Fall 2024 term	August 19 th
Last Date of employment for Student Employees/Work Studies for the Fall 2024 term	December 13 th
