



Laredo College 2022-2023 PROMISE Scholars Scholarship Application

DEADLINE: March 24

The PROMISE Scholars Project will create the linkages and provide leadership development and support for eligible students to complete an Associates Degree and transfer to complete their degree in Food, Agriculture, Natural Resources and Human (FANH) science at any of the partner universities.

The maximum PROMISE Scholars scholarship is \$5,000 per academic year (\$2,000/Fall/Spring; \$500 Summer), and the amount awarded will be based on this application in conjunction with the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the Laredo College Application for Admission, and the LEAPS/STEM Scholars program application (optional). Students who are awarded this scholarship may be eligible for a university postsecondary scholarship of \$25,000.

The PROMISE Scholars Scholarships are merit scholarships, based on past and continued student performance in specific instructional STEM programs including but not limited to agriculture, animal health, food safety, environmental microbiology, aquaculture, and animal science. Participation in this scholarship may provide additional opportunities with our partnering universities (i.e., Texas A&M University Kingsville (TAMUK), University of Texas El Paso (UTEP), University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV), and Texas State university (TSU)).

To be eligible for the scholarship students must:

- Must be an incoming Freshman or Sophomore and be 18 years or older.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or a permanent resident to be eligible for awarding of the scholarship
- Maintain an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 on a four-point scale;
- Present student research/poster during the URO Symposium
- Plan to complete a minimum of 30 semester credit hours within a year (fall, spring, and summer semesters or equivalent).
- Complete at least 80 percent of all semester credit hours attempted for each semester in the prior year (fall, spring, and summer semesters or equivalent)
- Participate in university tours (once COVID travel restrictions are eliminated).
- Be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours at Laredo College and have a self-declared major in one of the following:
 - Agriculture,
 - o Animal Science,
 - Veterinary Medicine
 - Animal health, production, and well-being;
 - Plant health and production;
 - Animal and plant germ plasm collection and preservation;
 - Aquaculture;

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- Food safety;
- Soil and water conservation and improvement;
- Forestry, horticulture, and range management;
- Farm enhancement, including financial management, input efficiency, and profitability;
- Home economics;
- Rural human ecology;
- Youth development and agricultural education, including 4–H clubs;
- Expansion of domestic and international markets for agricultural commodities and products, including agricultural trade barrier identification and analysis;
- Information management and technology transfer related to agriculture;
- Biotechnology related to agriculture;
- Big DATA related to agriculture; and
- The processing, distributing, marketing, and utilization of food and agricultural products.
