The **Worksheet** tab contains two side bar options (Academic, What-If). As previously noted, this is where you will see your degree audit.

Class History

The Class History option is located at the top right of the page when you click the three horizontal ellipses. **Class History** allows you to view taken and transferred coursework. This looks similar to an unofficial transcript. All the classes you have transferred appear at the top, and the classes you have taken at LC appear towards the bottom.
