Who is eligible: Students who are planning to transfer to TAMIU into the systems engineering/computer science engineering program can apply for this scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements ♦ Must be a current Laredo College student who is majoring in engineering

♦ Must plan on transferring to TAMIU

♦ Must have passed their TSI exams

♦ Must have a complete FAFSA application

◊ Student must be advised by assigned individuals

Application Process

- 1. Ensure you have been admitted into the college
- 2. Complete your FAFSA application

3. Declare your major as "engineering technology"

4. Submit a complete application form as well as copies of proof to <u>EDCMT@laredo.edu</u>

Incomplete applications will not be accepted

Re-application is needed every new semester

Selection Process and Considerations

Students interested and who have submitted a complete application will be eligible to receive a \$1,000 scholarship at the end of a full-term semester (16 weeks). Students with a complete application will then be scheduled to interview with a department scholarship committee and present their progress within the program.

Some factors the committee will take into consideration:

- First-generation college student status
- Student involvement in department and/or extra-curricular activities
- GPA, good academic standing, and progress/improvement
- Financial need
