

Associate of Arts/Science Degree Guide

General Studies

The Associate of Arts/Science (AA/AS) degree consists of two components: 42 SCH of the Texas Common Core Curriculum (TCCC) and 18 SCH of general electives (GE). This degree is best suited for students who plan to transfer to a university to complete a Bachelor's degree and/or for students who have not yet declared a major but are interested in academic disciplines. Only academic courses are applicable to the 18 SCH of general electives required for this degree. General electives should be selected based on college major and transfer institution.
