

## Associate of Arts / Associate of Science Degree Guide 2022 - 2023

The Associate of Arts/Science (AA/AS) degree requires completion of two components: 42 semester credit hours (SCH) of the Texas Core Curriculum or "basics" (listed in **bold**) and 18 SCH (minimum) of **general electives**. This degree is best suited for students who plan to transfer to a university to complete a bachelor's degree or for students who have not yet declared a major but are interested in pursuing academic disciplines. To complete this degree in two years, students are recommended to register for the number of SCH listed under each semester. If unable to do so, students are strongly encouraged to consult with an advisor to discuss possible course options for the summer and/or winter terms.
